Choir Tour, June 11-15

Then on Sunday morning we will sing at an 8:45 contemporary service and an 11:00 traditional service at Timberlake Baptist Church. On Monday, we will have the privilege of ministering with Sea Haven, a home for runaway and homeless youth. We will spend the day with these kids and learn about the challenge of being a teenager without a family. On Tuesday we will have a free day at the beach.

We will pack the van at 8:30 on Saturday morning and leave by 9:00. We will return on Wednesday around 4:00. A more detailed schedule and packing list will be emailed to you by June 3.
